



Primary PE Sports Grant/Premium: 2020-21

What is the Sports Premium Grant?

The School Sport Premium Grant is a Government package of funding for Primary School PE school sports, provided by the Department of Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport. Funding is allocated through a lump sum and a small per pupil top up and can only be spent on sport and PE provision in school. As an academy, payments will be paid directly from the Education Funding Agency (EFA)

Purpose, Vision, Objective & Key Indicators

Purpose of funding:

Schools must spend the total funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this.

Vision:

All pupils leaving primary school physically literate and with the knowledge, skills and motivation necessary to equip them for a healthy lifestyle and lifelong participation in physical activity and sport.

Objective:

To achieve self-sustaining improvement in the quality of PE and sport in primary schools.

Indicators of such improvement to include:

There are 5 key indicators that schools should expect to see improvement across:

- The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity – the Chief Medical Officer guidelines recommend that all children and young people aged 5 to 18 engage in at least 60 minutes of physical activity a day, of which 30 minutes should be in school
- The profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole-school improvement

- Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
- Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
- Increased participation in competitive sport

In our Academy, the 2018-19 allocation is £19,570 and we are using it to maintain what we have achieved over the recent years in PE. We will continue to deliver high quality PE lessons across the school and continue to improve confidence and expertise amongst staff in the delivery of high quality PE lessons across the whole school. We endeavour to provide continuous professional development (CPD) for our staff by building on the training we have provided in previous years where we worked alongside Wilmslow High in team teaching to build expertise in a range of sports across the key stages and is now being put into practise. We have ensured specialist teachers from outside agencies such as Rebecca Adlington's 'Swim Stars' 'Rattle N Roll' Dance are there to enhance the teaching provided to our pupils giving them the best opportunity to develop in key aspects of the sports we teach in PE at Gorsey Bank. We have also worked alongside the PE specialist teachers from the Laurus Trust in providing CPD with our KS2 teachers. These opportunities are invaluable to our teachers, as it enables them the opportunity not just to develop their own skill set but also to assess the children whilst they are being taught.

In response to staff asking for more training and support in a range of areas of PE where they feel less experienced and confident, those needs are continuing to be met linked to sport specific targeted support. We will continue to train existing and new staff according to their needs and utilise the skill set of all our teachers where we can to ensure best practise is in place.

We believe that by investing in specialist coaches/teachers working alongside our staff is the most effective, sustainable and efficient way for the funding to have long lasting and positive effects on the future learning and physical development of the children at Gorsey Bank.
