BEHAVIOUR SYSTEM

Following feedback from the recent Parent Council meeting, we'd like to explain how our updated behaviour system works:

- Stage 1 (S1): A verbal reminder is given to the child about their behaviour.
- **Stage 2 (S2):** If the behaviour continues, parents will be notified. The student will spend 5 minutes of break or lunchtime with their teacher to discuss what happened and how to improve.

If a student receives 3 or more S2s in one month, this will move directly to Stage 4.

- Stage 3 (S3): For any serious incident, even if it happens only once, the child will meet with a member of the leadership team. Parents will be informed.
- Stage 4 (S4): If behaviour does not improve, a
 meeting will be arranged with parents in school. At this
 stage, a behaviour plan may be introduced.
- Stage 5 (S5): A final meeting with senior leadership will take place. A behaviour plan will be implemented and reviewed regularly.

Our aim is to support every child in making positive choices and to work closely with families to ensure success.

CAFT CHRISTMAS COLLECTION
