ATTENDANCE

As we approach the festive season, I'd like to remind everyone of the importance of full school attendance. While we understand families may wish to enjoy Christmas celebrations and events, attending school every day is essential for your child's academic progress as well as their personal and social development.

In Summer 2024, new government guidance introduced stricter rules regarding term-time absences. Local Authorities can issue fines if a child has five or more days of unauthorised absence. The first fine can be up to £160 per parent per child; subsequent fines will be at least this amount, and repeated cases may lead to criminal proceedings.

Absences may be authorised in exceptional circumstances, but these should be kept to an absolute minimum. If you need to request an absence, please submit your request in writing to admin@gorseybank.org.uk.
