## **DIGITAL WELLBEING**

We can no longer discuss the wellbeing and personal development of our young people without doing so in the context of technology - it is everywhere in their lives and while we know how amazing it can be, it poses huge risks on many many levels outside the traditional perception of 'eSafety'. In short, caring for our children now necessarily means being concerned about their relationship with the digital world.

This is hard for us as parents; it is an area most of us never had an education on ourselves and balancing the social aspect of technology with wanting to keep our young people protected amidst a constantly shifting digital landscape is fraught with issues.

Over the next couple of weeks we will be sharing lots of information about our new whole school approach to Digital Wellbeing, sharing resources on our website and crucially asking you to engage in new guidance which will be shared next week (with accompanying short video) and has the sole purpose of ensuring a collaborative approach between parents and their children to ensure technology plays a positive role in child development, rather than a damaging one.

#### **Twitter next steps**

As we shared in last week's newsletter, we have taken the decision to restrict access to our year group Twitter (X) Feeds so that only those users pre-approved by the school can view posts. The job of clearing all existing Followers has now been completed and early next week you will receive guidance through the MCAS app on how to request to follow your child/children's Twitter accounts. This will come direct to you though this channel to allow us to verify your accounts for approval.

#### Visyon session for parents - 6th February 6-7.30pm

To further support parents in supporting their children's Digital Wellbeing, we have arranged for the mental health charity Visyon to join us in school on the evening of Tuesday 6th February. Visyon describe the session as follows:

This workshop looks at how to support your child with peer pressure and online bullying. Learn how to build their self-esteem and break through the negativity of the 24-hour online world. Look at how to support a child with a healthy relationship with the online world and get over the FOMO (Fear of Missing Out).


