DIGITAL WELLBEING – YOU MAY NOT BE TAKING THIS SERIOUSLY ENOUGH

As a parent of a 13 year old girl, the relationship she has with technology is pretty much top of my list of worries. I worry about how it will affect her self image, her attention span, her view of the world, her perception of what 'friendship' actually is, her ability to sleep, her ability to engage in conversation with adults, her physical development, her management of money . . . and that's before I start to worry about people targeting her from the outside for scams or much much worse.

Whatever the age of your child, if you don't share those concerns then you're either completely on top of this all (which is great) or you've possibly not taken the time to fully consider the full range of dangers technology poses to the wellbeing of your child.

At present the response rate to our digital wellbeing home agreement is shockingly low - it's a six minute video and a form which takes two minutes (plus whatever discussion you feel would be useful to have with your child) both designed solely to help you support the wellbeing of your child.
