SUN SAFETY

DOGS ON SCHOOL GROUNDS

A reminder that no dogs should be brought on to school grounds, even if they are being carried. Many pupils and parents feel uncomfortable around dogs. There have been several serious dog attacks in the news and one in particular at a school in Birmingham in 2023 which served as a warning to all schools. Please do not wait with dogs at the front of school, inside the school boundary or use the fence line to tie them up around the car park. Dogs may be securely tied to the fence at the rear of the grounds (well away from the entrance gate) otherwise we would request you leave them at home.
