# KIDS CLUB BOOKINGS FOR SEPTEMBER

Details of the booking process for our Kids Club provision for September will be sent out next week. Please read the letter carefully to understand the timelines involved and guidance on how to request your priority sessions.

You will only be able to make requests to book Kids Club places via the booking link, details of which will also be found in the letter and will go 'live' from week commencing Monday 19th May.

A reminder that any requested sessions allocated will be charged until at least October Half Term so we will be asking you to only request sessions you absolutely need. We would also remind existing users of Kids Club they will need to reapply for any sessions required from September.

#### **FAMILY HELP**





#### ATTENDANCE

Full attendance at school is critical not only for your child's academic success but also for their personal and social development. Last summer, new government guidance came into force regarding fines for term time absences. Fines are typically issued by the Local Authority if a child has an unauthorised absence for 5 days or more. The first time a family incurs a fine it could be up to £160 per parent per child, a second will be at least this figure and any further instances could result in a criminal conviction.

There are exceptional circumstances in which short term time absences can be authorised but even these should of course be kept to a minimum. Should you need to request an absence, this must be submitted in writing to admin@gorseybank.org.uk.
