It was especially lovely to see our pupils getting so involved this year. Their enthusiasm and entrepreneurial spirit really shone through at the fair – we couldn't be prouder!

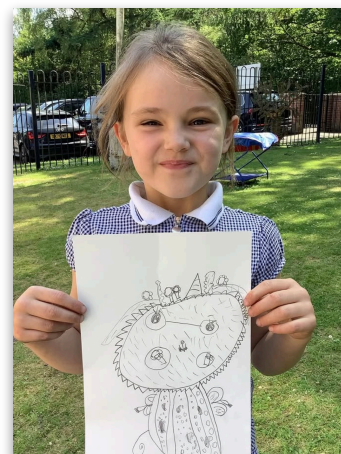
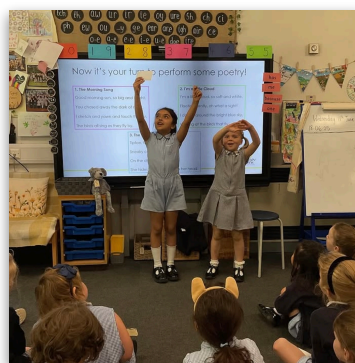

A huge thank you to **Love Music Trust** and to **Mrs Lavelle** for organising and supporting this fantastic event.



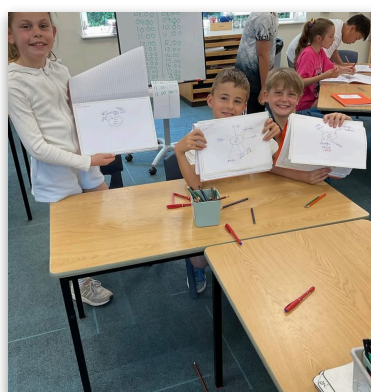
LAURUS LIVE
