You have the right to find out things and say what you think, unless it breaks the rights of others.

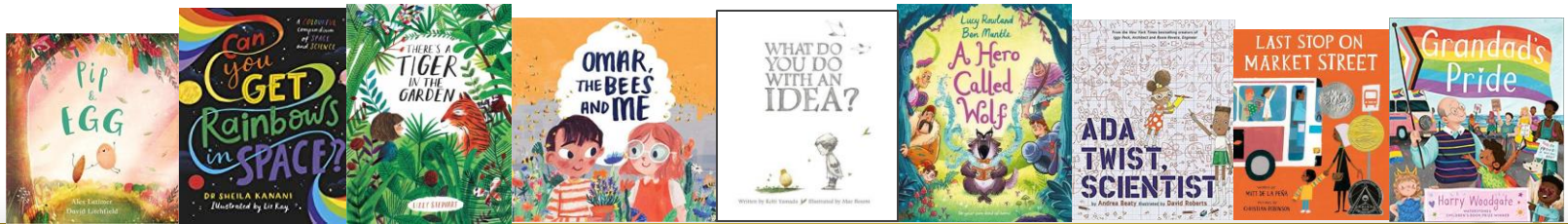


Article 17
